# Wellbeing



Preparing for GCSEs can be a stressful time, especially in the lead up to exams. Here are some suggestions for how to maintain wellbeing for students through this challenging time.

1. **Self-care** – It is really important that you don't see looking after yourself as selfish or that you don't have time for it. You need to achieve a...
2. **Balance** – Of course you will need to revise and study but you also need to make sure you get enough sleep, relaxation and stay active as all of these are proven to keep you healthy mentally.
3. **Know that you are not alone** – Most of the feelings you will have during this time will be completely normal and experienced by many others. Dispel the idea that you are strange and everyone else is coping and instead ...
4. **Remember to share your** experiences by talking about them at home, with friends and with school. Simply the act of talking may help the issue and if not, everyone will want to help.
5. **Avoid perfectionism and comparisons** – remember that no one is perfect and that you are good enough. Concentrate on doing your best and don't compare that to what you think others can do. No one can expect you to do better than your best so why expect more than that of yourself.
6. **Be resilient** – try to see setbacks as part of the journey to success and mistakes as an opportunity to learn and progress.
7. **Social media and use of devices** – these can have lots of positive effects but do consider any negative impacts that overuse may be having. If you find yourself feeling bad about yourself while or after looking at posts or that you are constantly checking your phone consider whether these are healthy habits and whether you should cut back.
